October 2nd is Gandhi's Birthday and International Day of Non-Violence. October 4th is the Feast Day of St. Francis of Assisi, another great peacemaker. In honor of these two days and in celebration of the heroes and heroines of non-violence from all of the world's great religious traditions Interfaith Paths to Peace invites you to a very special event on Sunday, October 4th at 3:30 p.m. in "The Barn" behind St. Agnes Church at 1920 Newburg Road (park in the church lot, then walk up the driveway to behind the church). Among the other sponsors of this event are St. William and St. Agnes Catholic Churches, Pax Christi, the Peace and Justice Division of the Episcopal Diocese of Kentucky, Louisville's Chapter of the Fellowship of Reconciliation, The Drepung Gomang (Tibetan Buddhist) Institute, and Iranians for Peace.

The event itself will include music, prayers, readings, poetry, and other forms of expression celebrating the great figures of non-violent direct action throughout history. These include not just Gandhi and St. Francis, but also Dorothy Day, Martin Luther King, Jr., Thich Nhat Hanh, Pema Chodron, Abdul Gaffar Khan, Abraham Joshua Heschel, Thomas Merton, and many others.

The 2009 Drepung Gomang Tour will offer prayers as part of the event.

Among the peacemakers whose lives and gifts will be celebrated is Jim McGinnis a Catholic peacemaker and non-violence educator who died suddenly in August and is deeply missed by peacemakers in all religions.
